

## Sports premium Report 2016-2017

In the academic year 2016-2017, Fossebrook Primary school received £8155 in sports premium funding.

Of this, £3671.47 was spent on staff wages for the provision of lunchtime sport activities and after school sports clubs which were offered free of charge for the pupils.

The remaining £4483.53 was used to purchase PE equipment to enable the provision of a wide range of sports activities both within PE lessons as well as lunchtime and after school clubs.

### Lunchtime sport:

This involved timetabled activities for children in all year groups to work with the sports coach to develop teamwork and leadership as well as develop skills in a range of sports. The sports offered included multi-skills, football and hockey. As well as this, a variety of equipment is provided on the playground in order for all children to have access to sport activities: e.g. skipping ropes, hoops, beanbags and bats, basketball hoops. These activities are supervised and organised by the lunchtime staff in consultation with the sports coach.

### After school sports:

Throughout the year a variety of sports clubs were offered to children from all age groups on a first come first served basis. These included football, gymnastics, dance, hockey, dodgeball, athletics, basketball and multi-skills. Waiting lists were kept and registration was offered termly to ensure children were able to participate in a range of clubs throughout the year.

### Team competitions:

The school is part of the Hinckley and Bosworth School Development Group as well as DSAT. Due to the age of our pupils, the competitions we are currently able to access are limited but we did enter a KS1 gymnastic team in the Hinckley and Bosworth network at which they came 4<sup>th</sup> overall. As we will have KS2 pupils next year the scope for competition entry will grow.
